Using our publications

Carers Trust produces a range of publications. If you would like to make use of these resources please refer to the following frequently asked questions.

Can I print or photocopy any of the Carers Trust publications?

Individuals and organisations are welcome to print and photocopy any complete publication from any Carers Trust website. Organisations are free to distribute them to service users and colleagues, but must ensure that Carers Trust is acknowledged as the copyright holder.

It is also fine to refer others to publications on any Carers Trust website.

Can I use content/images from Carers Trust publications?

If you would like to use content or images from Carers Trust publications please contact our Editorial Manager, at editorial@carers.org.

Can I display cover images from Carers Trust publications on web pages, or in any other publishable format?

Carers Trust is generally happy for organisations to display cover images, but please get permission from our Editorial Manager, at editorial@carers.org before uploading or printing the cover image.

Where cover images are displayed we would expect a referral to Carers Trust's general website Carers.org.
